Ebor Vale Riding Club would you like you to:

Keep yourself safe by listening to club officials, your coach or instructor, behave responsibly, set a good example and speak out when something isn't right

- Take care of EVRC equipment and premises as if they were your own
- Arrive on time or if you are running late, let the relevant club official / coach / instructor know
- Wear the appropriate clothing for the activity and weather
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Respect and celebrate differences in EVRC and not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation or ability
- Report any incidents of bullying, including homophobia and transphobia to a club official even if you're just a witness
- Treat other people with respect and appreciate that everyone has different levels of skill and talent
- Make EVRC a welcoming and friendly place to be
- Support and encourage each other
- Respect EVRC coaches, instructors, club officials and any officials from other clubs, Areas or BRC – and respect their decisions
- Know the rules and ride within them
- Follow EVRC's policies (available on the EVRC website)
- When posting any photos on social media please be aware of other members, competitors, volunteers or spectators in the background and check they are happy for you to upload them
- Any fees for training or competitions must be paid promptly

As a Member taking part EVRC understands you have the right to:

- Enjoy the time you spend with the club
- Be told who you can talk to if something's not right
- Be listened to
- Be respected by the club and be treated fairly
- Feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality or ability
- Be encouraged and develop new skills
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury and have someone nominated by you informed if necessary
