Code of Conduct: Junior Members

Ebor Vale Riding Club would you like you to:

Keep yourself safe by listening to club officials, your coach or instructor, behave responsibly and speak out when something isn't right

- When you're with EVRC, stay in the places where you're supposed to, don't wander off or leave without telling the coach, instructor, EVRC official
- Take care of EVRC equipment and premises as if they were your own
- Arrive on time or if you are running late, let the relevant club official / coach / instructor know
- Wear the appropriate clothing for the activity and weather
- Do not smoke, vape or consume alcohol or any other prohibited substances at the venue or during the activities
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Respect and celebrate differences in EVRC and not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation or ability
- Report any incidents of bullying, including homophobia and transphobia to a club official even if you're just a witness
- Treat other people with respect and appreciate that everyone has different levels of skill and talent
- Make EVRC a welcoming and friendly place to be
- Support and encourage each other
- Respect EVRC coaches, instructors, club officials and any officials from other clubs, Areas or BRC – and respect their decisions
- Ride within the rules
- Follow EVRC's policies (available on the EVRC website)
- When posting any photos on social media please be aware of other members, competitors, volunteers or spectators in the background and check they are happy for you to upload them

As a Junior Member taking part EVRC understands you have the right to:

- Enjoy the time you spend with the club
- Be told who you can talk to if something's not right
- Be listened to
- Be respected by the club and be treated fairly
- Feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality or ability
- Be encouraged and develop new skills
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury and have your parents informed if necessary
